SPARSPARKLING WINES

Prosecco Superiore BRUT Colesel Valdobbiadene, Veneto

125ml £5.20 | Bottle £27.00

Luminous and fresh, this is a classic Prosecco with all the lively effervescence and the cheerful personality you can expect from this popular Italian sparkler. It's creamy and smooth in the mouth and offers plenty of citric freshness.

Champagne Brut Grande Reserve, Laforge Testa, France

Bottle £55.00

Champagne is just so evocative of good taste and there are plenty of small family Champagne houses making excellent wine such as Laforge-Testa. A lovely elegant yeasty, biscuit nose that so typifies good Champagne. On the palate it is so and rounded with just a touch of earthiness and a good length.

Viticoltori Acquesi Rose' Brut, Piemonte

Bottle £28.00

A beautiful pale pink colour, with a delicate aroma of spring flowers and orchard fruit, refined bubbles, and a crisp fruity finish.

ROSÉ WINES

Pinot Grigio Rosè, Veneto 2019

125ml £5.90 | 175ml £7.90 | Bottle £23.00

Pale coral pink, this is a dry, fresh and fruity rose with delicate aromas of red berries. Soft and creamy textured - with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit, and a vibrant finish.

Calafuria Negroamaro Rosato, Tormaresca, Antinori Puglia 2018

Bottle £35.00

On the nose, Calafuria offers fruity notes of peaches, pink grapefruit and pomegranate that merge with delicate floral sensations of wisteria flowers. Its palate is supple, bright with pleasing freshness in perfect balance with its aromatic persistence with a delicate savory note on the finish.

WHITE WINES

Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi DOC, Marche 2019

125ml £5.90 | 175ml £7.90 | Bottle £23.00

It is an aromatic white wine with a delicate bouquet of floral and fruity notes. On the palate it is dry, fresh and flavoursome. A full-bodied wine with a slightly bitter aftertaste.

Pinot Grigio Friuli Grave DOC Lamis, 2018

125ml £6.50 | 175ml £8.60 | Bottle £25.00

A light sappy nose with a distinctive almond tone. On the palate it is rounded and with a lively crispness on the finish.

Chardonnay Friuli Grave DOC Claps, 2019

125ml £7.00 | 175ml £9.20 | Bottle £27.00

A mix of delicious smells, with a touch of honey and citrus then followed by a lovely rounded flavour and a clean, crisp, long finish.

Sauvignon Colli Piacentini DOC, Emilia Romagna 2018

125ml £7.00 | 175ml £9.50 | Bottle £28.00

A deliciously crisp and grassy finish follows a firm and distinctly herbal note. There is a slight softness in the middle.

Gavi di Gavi La Contessa, Piemonte, 2019

Bottle £32.00

This "Baby Gavi" hails from Broglia, the famous Gavi di Gavi house.

A lovely creamy wine with fresh melon, apple, citrus and mineral aromas. Rich structure with a soft balanced finish.

Pecorino IGT Colline Pescaresi Trabocchetto, Abruzzo 2018

Bottle £35.00

This recently re-discovered grape variety shows the depth and diversity of Italy's vines and wines. A great little number. A lovely soft rounded wine with a good weight on the palate and a lovely long slightly herby finish.

Greco di Tufo DOCG Villa Matilde, Campania, 2019

Bottle £37.00

Bold flavours of white peach and apricot give way to notes of citrus and an appealing mineral streak. The palate is rich and well structured and the finish leaves a subtle yet lingering flavour of sweet almonds.

Vermentino di Gallura DOCG Piras, Sardegna 2018

Bottle £40.00

This Vermentino from the Gallura region of Sardinia is top class stuff hence the DOCG award. A bone dry and well-structured wine with both citrusy lemon tone and a fleshy peach flavour on the middle palate and a crisp, balanced finish.

RED WINES

Merlot Friuli Grave DOC, Friuli Venezia Giulia 2019

125ml £5.90 | 175ml £7.90 | Bottle £23.00

This Merlot has a beautiful ruby red colour and the scent of forest fruits. A dry, full, and at the same time soft and harmonious taste.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC Modà, Abruzzo 2018

125ml £6.50 | 175ml £8.60 | Bottle £25.00

An intense ruby-red color with violet undertones. Intense bouquet of ripe red fruit. Rich in fruit, lively, elegantly framed by oak spices.

Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG, Toscana 2018

125ml £6.80 | 175ml £8.90 | Bottle £26.00

A full flavoured wine with distinctly earthy tones. Quite rich on the nose, followed by a substantial breadth on the palate and good length on the finish.

Primitivo di Manduria DOC, Puglia 2018

125ml £7.20 | 175ml £9.50 | Bottle £28.00

After 18 months ageing in big oak barrels before bottling it's bouquet is rich and complex, with pleasant ripened fruits like blackberry and cherry, licorice and spice notes. Full bodied in taste, velvety, supple with good persistence.

Nero d'Avola Regaleali Rosso, Sicilia 2018

Bottle £30.00

This splendidly intense ruby red-coloured wine boasts warm, strong fragrances characterised by notes of cherry, black cherry, mulberry, blueberry, vanilla and sage. Soft on the palate and with just the right amount of tannins, this wine has a fresh balance to it. It closes with a lovely aroma of berries.

Barbera d'Asti DOCG Mon Ross, Piemonte 2019

Bottle £35.00

Barbera has been rediscovered over the last decade or so, such that we now have an exciting range of styles and qualities of this once everyday grape. A delicious fruity nose is followed by a rounded soft palate. On the finish it has distinct herbal tones.

Chianti Classico DOCG Castello della Paneretta, Toscana 2017

Bottle £42.00

It is high percentage of old vines is now making wines of great structure and length. Almost totally Sangiovese grapes and characterised by a firm ripeness and depth of flavour with a touch of cherries on the finish.

Barolo DOCG Bricco Gaiano, Piemonte 2014

Bottle £55.00

One of Italy's greatest wines that is ideal with well flavoured foods. An intense, perfumed nose, rich with mature, berry fruit that lingers. It fills the mouth with its density of flavour and firmness. A long dry finish.

Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG Terre d'Orti, Veneto 2016

Bottle £62.00

Amarone, a wine that is now regarded as one of Italy's jewels. Made from dried grapes grown in Valpolicella, near Verona, and with a full, dry flavour. A big, chunky wine with tones of damsons and herbs a full bodied rounded flavour and a long finish.

Brunello di Montalcino, Pian delle Vigne Antinori, Toscana 2014

Bottle £75.00

One of Italy's grandest wines, showing a complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Multi-layered structure with a nicely rounded texture and elegant fruit leading to a very long finish.
